Course Description

The purpose of Drama II is to give the student experience with a variety of theatre disciplines at an intermediate to advanced level.

Course Objectives

This class utilizes both the Michigan High School Content Standards in English and Performing Arts and the National Standards for Theatre Arts.

Student Expectations

This class is a PARTICIPATION and performance class. Theatre is a collaborative art and attendance is critical as students will be working with others daily. Students are required to productively rehearse and do their part of all group work, presentations, and performances. While here, all students will be expected to honor each other's creativity in a supportive environment.

Communication

Progress reports are sent home with students upon request. The teacher is available by appointment to meet with parents or students needing consultation or extra help.

Grading Policy

All work is expected to be the student's own and handed in on time. Exceptions or accommodations are to be discussed with the instructor before the assignment is due.

Scope and Sequence

Drama II features the study of acting techniques, a design portfolio unit, play and character analysis, theatre history, lots of performance and a bit of Shakespeare. Additionally, students will critique a play outside of class, which is the responsibility of the student to schedule and attend.
