Course Description

Reading Workshop II continues the work of progressing each student to increased skill levels in English Language Arts, with a focus on content reading and writing.

Course Objectives

This class is individualized to student needs so the standards achieved by each student may vary. The overall goal for each student is to improve their skill in academic reading.

Student Expectations

Active participation in the class will allow students to accelerate their improvement in all areas of academic literacy. Each student will be expected to work productively during each class period, whether on content for this class or on work in another academic area. Failure to do so may result in grade penalties or removal from class.

Communication

Progress reports are sent home with students upon request. The teacher is available by appointment to meet with parents or students needing consultation or extra help.

Grading Policy

All work is expected to be the student's own and handed in on time. Exceptions or accommodations are to be discussed with the instructor before the assignment is due.

As this class features individualized instruction, the scope and sequence will vary depending on student needs. The class will feature a variety of reading and writing opportunites and provide support for other academic content work.
