



Testing Descriptions for 2017-18

Michigan Math Prize Competition Test

This is a math competition test for which scholarships are awarded. Students must have taken or currently taking Algebra II. If students do well on Part I of the test, they will qualify to take Part II. Students may register in Student Services September 5-21, 2017 and the cost of Part I is \$15 payable in cash or check (made out to GHHS). Part I of the test will be given on the morning of October 10, 2017, and Part II will be held December 6, 2017. Both tests are given at GHHS.

10th and 11th Grade – PSAT/NMSQ test

Juniors are encouraged to take the PSAT/NMSQT to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship and practice for the SAT test. This is the only opportunity for juniors to qualify for the National Merit Scholars. The PSAT test is Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at GHHS. (This is a delayed start; you must furnish your own transportation.) Registration for the PSAT test runs from September 5-21, 2017 and the cost is \$30.00. Registration is in Student Services.

ACT

ACT testing opportunities will be available at GHHS on October 28, 2017, February 10, 2018 and June 9, 2018. Students must register on line at www.actstudent.org.

MME testing for all Juniors

All juniors must take the MME battery of 3 tests on April 10-12, 2018. Seniors who have not taken any or all of the MME test in their junior year will also be testing at this time. The MME includes the SAT college entrance exam with writing, ACT's WorkKeys-a work skills assessment, and M-Step with components of science and social studies. The state gives and pays for the MME test for each student. The MME tests are now a graduation requirement mandated by GHAPS Board of Education policy. The MME test scores will be available in time to be submitted to the student's college/university of choice in the fall of the student's senior year. All students taking the MME will be registering in school on March 21-22, 2018 at the high school.

9th and 10th grade PSAT Test

All GHHS freshmen and sophomores will be taking the PSAT Test on Tuesday, April 10, 2018. The PSAT is patterned after the SAT test and is a predictor of how well they will do on the SAT. It also gives them the availability of tutorial help in their weak area(s) through the Khan Academy. The PSAT scores will also be used for students to dual enroll for college courses. This test also gives students valuable practice with this type of testing.

Advanced Placement examinations

Students who are enrolled in AP courses and opting for the 5.0 GPA scale must take the College Board Advanced Placement examination in their course area(s). The cost of each exam is \$100. AP exams are held over a two week period from May 7-18, 2018. Late testing will be allowed only in extreme circumstances as outlined in the AP policy book. A high school principal must approve all late testing. Late testing will take place on May 23-25, 2018.
